

LIST OR MANIFEST OF ALIEN PASSENGERS FOR THE U. S. IMMIGRATION OFFICER AT PORT OF ARRIVAL.

Required by the regulations of the Secretary of Commerce and Labor of the United States, under Act of Congress approved March 3, 1903, to be delivered to the U. S. Immigration Officer by the Commanding Officer of any vessel having such passengers on board upon arrival at a port in the United States.

NOTE: This slip must be attached to the right side of each manifest of alien passengers. Cite Nos. 800, 800-A, and 800-A-1, and the information indicated by the headings given by the masters of vessels.

Table with columns for No. on List, Name in Full, Age, Sex, Color, Height, Weight, Eyes, Hair, Complexion, and Place of Birth. Includes handwritten entries for passengers like 'Hansen, Paul' and 'Hansen, Edward'.

* Record of identity certificate of natives and aliens is issued, state in column 6 whether they are "Natives" or "Aliens".
